

LOGO DESIGN CONTEST RULES FOR THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE INTERNATIONAL DOCKWORKERS COUNCIL (IDC)

Article 1. Objective

The International Dockworkers Council (IDC) announces a logo design contest to celebrate its 25th anniversary. The goal of the contest is to create an original, attractive, and identifiable logo that represents the values and history of the IDC over these 25 years.

Article 2. Participants

The contest is open to all workers affiliated with any IDC member union, or their direct relatives who are of legal age in their country of residence.

Article 3. Logo Design

The logo must be original, unpublished, and not previously submitted to any other contest or platform. The design should be creative, impactful, and easy to remember. It must represent the values of the IDC, such as solidarity, collective strength, the fight for workers' rights, and the importance of dock work for international trade. It should be noted that the official languages of the IDC are Spanish, English, and French, and if the logo includes text, it must be in all three languages.

Article 4. Format and Submission

Designs must be submitted in digital format (.jpg, .png, or .pdf) with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi. Each participant may submit a maximum of two designs. The designs must be accompanied by a brief explanatory report describing the concept of the design and its relation to the values of the IDC.

Article 5. Submission Deadline

Designs can be submitted from this July until October 31 of this year. Submissions should be sent by email to the following address: coordination@idcdockworkers.org.

Article 6. Jury

The contest jury will be composed of members of the IDC Permanent Commission (General Coordinator, International Labor Coordinator, Regional Coordinators) and Secretariat. The voting and selection of the winner will be announced in December of this year.

Article 7. Prizes

The contest winner, besides the pride of having their design represent the IDC during the next year, will receive a compensation determined at the discretion of our Organization at a later date.



Article 8. Usage Rights

The IDC will have the usage rights of the winning logo for its anniversary campaign and throughout 2025, and thereafter in commemorative events. The IDC may use the logo on any medium, both physical and digital, and for any purpose related to the anniversary celebration.

Article 9. Transfer of Rights

The contest winner must transfer to the IDC all intellectual property and exploitation rights of the winning logo. The winner will sign a rights transfer contract specifying the conditions of use of the logo.

Article 10. Acceptance of the Rules

Participation in the contest implies full acceptance of these rules. The IDC reserves the right to modify or cancel the contest at any time without prior notice.
